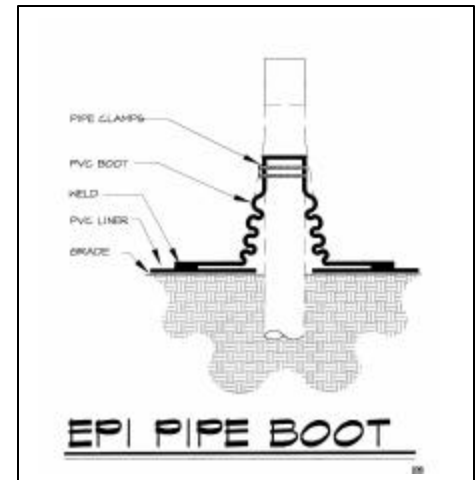
EPI @ EXPOMIN 2004
