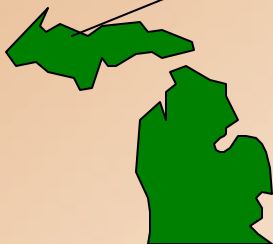

## Spring Work is Underway

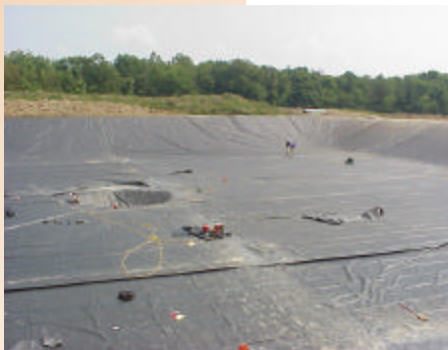

of 30 mil PVC for the closure of Young's Landfill in southern Michigan. Catskill Remedial Contracting Service is the prime contractor on the site. This project will be completed in early summer.
