of geosynthetics professionals. Dan has been very active in the development of an ASTM standard material specification for PVC geomembranes to replace the outdated, but still improperly used, NSF-54 standard for PVC.



Mark Wolschon is the Task Group Leader within Committee D35 that is currently working on completion of two new standards. They

are Work Item 2056; the previously mentioned Material Specification for PVC Geomembranes, and Work Item 3871; a new standard method for

Air Channel Testing Dual Track Thermally Welded PVC Seams. This new field seam test method will provide both continuity and peel strength testing of PVC field welds in one simple operation.

Brad DeArment has joined EPI as Installation Supervisor. Brad will be responsible for scheduling,



coordinating field crews, on-site supervision, field welding, and quality control on EPI's geomembrane installation projects throughout the country. Welcome Brad!
