Temporary Containment Liners

EPI has developed a simple, economical solution for all of your small containment needs.

Whether it's a barrel, under piping, a small tank, or a frac tank, we can fabricate any size

liner for your temporary containment needs.



The vertical sides can be created with 2x4, 2x6, or 2x8 lumber. The area and depth depend on the amount of fluid to be contained. Simply slide the wood form in the sleeve of the liner, nail the corners, stake as required along the outside for support, and a

strong, stable vertical sidewall is created.

The liners are shipped folded flat and smaller sizes can be sent via UPS or FedEx as necessary.

The wood form material and stakes can be purchased at any



lumberyard. The wood corners are simply nailed together to form a rigid, vertical dike for the perimeter of the flexible liner.

30 mil PVC is the minimum recommended material for this application, but EPI can also supply 40 and 60 mil PVC, or reinforced Coolguard and Polypropylene geomembrane for the liner.

Give us a call and we can fabricate these temporary containment liners for you in virtually any size.
